During my first trip to Mexico, I looked up the painter Ignacio Aguerre, whom I had met in New York when I was an art student. Ignacio introduced me to most of the artists in the Taller Grafico in Mexico City, including Pablo Higgins, Mendez, and Siqueros. When I returned to New York in 1952, I had a solo show at the Roosevelt House on East 65th Street, where I met my future wife. After we were married, we lived in Spain, and traveled throughout Europe and North Africa.

Back in New York, I became the Director of the Visual Arts Center (Greenwich Village) of the Children's Aid Society. I administrated the program, as well as teaching painting and drawing to both children and adults from 1969-1999.

Born in New York City, 1925. Married to Mildred, 1952. Two sons. My paintings represent work in oil paint and mixed media, using images in an attempt to concretize a world of highly personal mythology. I have also created highly glazed, imaginative and mythological portraits of animals, as well as expressionistic landscapes and self-portraits.

I became interested in doing book art in the 1960s, attempting to create an intimate use of imagery. The process has continued to this day, and it has included what I believe to be some of my most personal imagery. These books are influenced by medieval illustrated manuscripts, creating jewellike drawings imbued with a modern sensibility and with the use of line drawings, as well as collage. These books are executed in a style reminiscent of gothic imagery.
